

2022 Canada Summer Games Age Categories

The Canada Games Council (CGC) has worked collaboratively with all National Sport Organizations (NSOs) on the 2022 Canada Summer Games program to develop each sport specific technical package.

Age categories have been identified for each sport with the goal to develop Canada's next generation of national team athletes in the "Train to Compete" phase of the Long Term Athlete Development Model (LTAD), or other suitable phase of LTAD as justified by the NSO, and approved by the CGC Sport Committee.

The CGC Sport Committee has approved the following age categories for the sports on the 2022 Canada Summer Games program:
