Four Medals Kick start week 2 at Niagara Falls 2022 of Canada Summer Games -

NIAGARA FALLS, ON – Team Alberta finishes day one of week 2 at the 2022 Canada Summer Games with four more medals to the count.

Team AB's women's time trials kick started week two's medal haul today. Mairén Lawson (Grande-prairie) shot out of the gates and put her head down and got to work. Lawson, who was previously a triathlete, decided to focus solely on biking in 2021 to improve her skills and did she ever show us that today. Lawson started her time trial with a strong start and inches away to close the gap between first place Ontario cyclist. After a strong fight to the finish Lawson finishes .4 seconds behind first place.

Track and field throwing events took a shot at the podium today. Team AB's Veteran and 2022 Shot Put Canadian Para record holder Jasmyn McCulloch (Calgary) aimed high by throwing a 516.00m length. McCulloch finished with a silver medal behind New Brunswick who threw a strong 557.00m length.

The track throwing events were on fire after McCulloch's performance. Andrew Livingstone (Edmonton) shot on the men's para side a 144.00m in length. Livingstone stepped on the podium revealing his third-place finish behind Team Saskatchewan's 357.00m length.

The women's hammer throw completed today's medal haul with Osereme Omosun (Calgary) hammering down a bronze medal finish with a 54.37m, which placed her just ahead of teammate Caithlyn Bailes who placed fourth in this event.

Alberta currently sits in fourth position in the medal standings behind Team Quebec with 67 medals (23 Gold, 19 Silver and 25 Bronze).
