



2022 Canada Summer Games Team Alberta Daily Highlights Day 3

August 9th, 2022

Third day of competition wraps up with an impressive new record and more hardware!

NIAGARA FALLS, ON – Team Alberta finishes the third day of competitions at the 2022 Niagara Canada Summer Games with impressive results! St. Albert local baseball player Eric Hartman starts the day by striking out a 9 year old Canada Games RBI record on the diamond in Oaks Park. The men's baseball team battled hard against eastern province Quebec to a swing winning score of 6 - 1.

Jacob van Geel (Calgary) and Colby Nemeth (Red Deer) hit the court today with an amazing rally against Team Manitoba serving them to a 2-1 match score in men's beach volleyball. The team ran out of steam later in the day while facing Team British Columbia, falling short with losing 2 straight sets. Our women's team then brought back the winning spirit by leading the way and serving Team Nova Scotia with a sweeping score of 2-0.

Following this impressive winning rally, the swim team continued its hardware collection in the pool, splashing across the finish line in all three colours adding 10 medals to the count for Team Alberta. Breanna White (Sherwood Park) continued her winning waves by collecting a silver in the 100m Backstroke Para Female. Reid Maxwell (St. Albert) followed right behind adding a splash of silver and bronze in the men's para swimming events. Our three golden boys Hunter Helberg (Fort McMurray), Tanner Cole (Edmonton) and Connor Bisett (Edmonton) swam their way to victory today by completing Alberta's sweep and adding three more gold medals to the count.

- Silver Medal: Breanna White (Sherwood Park) 100m Backstroke Para Female and in the 100m Fly Para Female, Reid Maxwell (St.Albert) 100m Fly Para Men's
- **Bronze Medal:** Sienna Rodgers (Calgary) 100m Backstroke Female, Reid Maxwell (St. Albert) 100m Backstroke Para Male, Addison Butler (Irricana) 50m Fly Male, 4x100m Freestyle Relay Female.
- Baseball Record: A RBI 2013 Sherbrooke Summer Games gets broken by Eric Hartman (St. Albert)
